

CITY OF DESOTO – SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

June 10, 2010

Mayor Chapman called the meeting to order at 7:00pm.

Answering roll call was: Mike Bach, Steve Cox, Ted Hansen, Brandon Hutcheson. Absent Dale Dippold.

Staff present included City Clerk Marcia Thomas.

Motion by Bach/Hansen to approve agenda: Bach,Cox,Hansen,Hutcheson all in favor: Motion carried 4-0.

Discussion took place regarding goals the Mayor and City Council would like to see for De Soto in the next few years. Sidewalks were one of the top priorities; especially from Hwy 169 to the school, to the library and park. Mayor Chapman is going to get together with Public Works Supervisor, Van Langen, and have a map drawn out for which streets the City would start with. The fire department's top priority would be a new pumper truck. Councilman Hansen said one of his top priorities would be a Community Building. Water treatment and waste water regulations are also top priorities. Councilman Bach said his neighbors stated they would like to see a larger library. Annexation was discussed. Mayor Chapman is planning another meeting in August or September for further discussions.
